

Survivor's Checklist

To Do Immediately After Death
Check for any written instructions for the body disposition, funeral plans and other
details on mywonderfullife.com
Notify Funeral home (if necessary)
Contact family, friends, and co-workers who may not be aware of the death (see
your loved one's MyWonderfulLife.com book for whom to contact)
Gather information for obituary and contact newspapers
Contact deceased's employer
Take security precautions
- Assign a house sitter
- Remove valuable items from deceased's house
- Forward mail
- Cancel newspapers
Remove any jewelry from deceased
Funeral Arrangements to be made*
Select clergy
Choose funeral home
Decide the location of the service
Decide on place and time of funeral service
Inquire about special religious services
Choose a burial container
Choose a burial site (find burial property documentation of ownership)
Decide either outer burial container or crypt
Pick out clothing for the deceased (if necessary)
Choose scripture to be read
Choose individual(s) to read eulogies
Pick type of flowers and music
Choose pallbearers
Order a funeral limousine
Find type of religious, fraternal or military service of deceased
Choose the memorial type and inscription
Sign necessary papers for burial permit
Choose a charitable organization(s) to receive donations
